The author examines four approaches to the question of moral development - the Learning Approach, the Cognitive Approach, the Humanistic Approach and the Psychoanalytic Approach - and points out their value as well as their shortcomings. She concludes that "totality of what it means to be moral can be understood only in the context of Christian theology". "Godliness is the ultimate expression of what it means to be moral". Despite a few unacceptable assertions, both pastors, teachers and psychologists will profit from a careful reading of this book.
